CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION (COR) FEE SCHEDULE (EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2007)

CORs are issued on a calendar year basis unless stated otherwise on the COR. All COR applications (except rehabilitation) must be accompanied by a **\$10 nonrefundable handling fee, which is in addition to the below-listed fees**

Applications for activities which require an inspection (e.g., private pond, aviculture installation, bobcat propagation) must also be accompanied by a **\$100 nonrefundable inspection fee**. If an application is approved, the COR will be issued and applicant billed for the balance due, which must be submitted within 15 days of receipt. Every effort will be made to combine *like* activities on one COR. **NOTE: THERE ARE NO DOLLAR AMOUNT THRESHOLDS--IT'S EITHER PERSONAL USE OR COMMERCIAL USE. ALSO, THERE IS NO DIFFERENTIATION BETWEEN RESIDENT AND NONRESIDENT FEES.**
